Special Guests include the Honorable Dave Kleis, St. Cloud Mayor; and Dr. Marion Judish, violin.

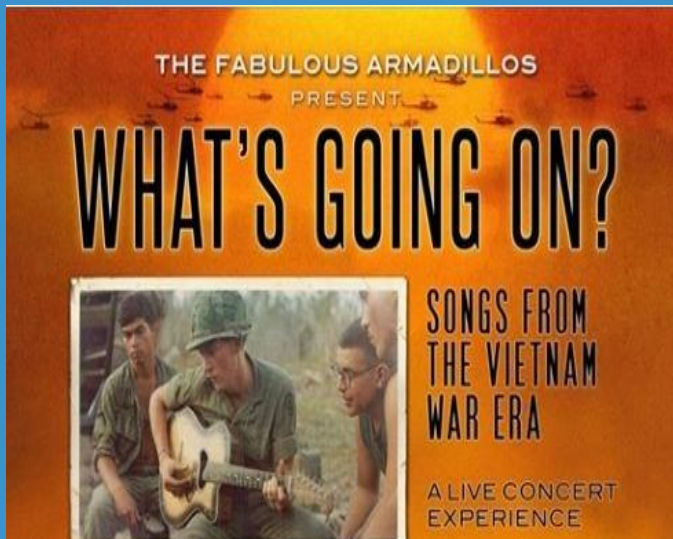

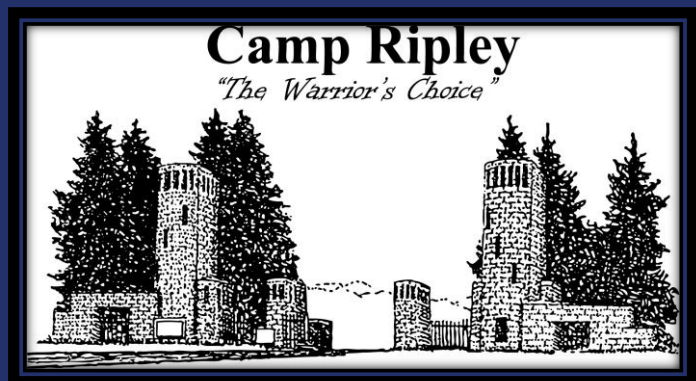
