Parking is available to the north and east of Building 8.






Texas Road House — Veterans and active military receive a free lunch from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. at all Texas

Special Guests include the Honorable Dave Kleis, St. Cloud Mayor; and Dr. Marion Judish, violin.


