
"Respect people at MACV because this is an incredible opportunity to work with a fantastic organization" -Housed Navy Veteran John

It was there at the shelter where he was connected to our MACV outreach team. From the shelter, the outreach team worked with John to find supportive housing. John remembers during his transition, "all my case managers were so incredible, and I am so thankful!"
