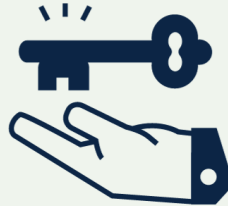
CFO of the Year 2023 Small Nonprofit: Brian Peterson
